### **Benefits of M&E**

- Is the project working?
- Is it worthwhile?
- Is it an efficient and effective use of resources?
- What can be changed to improve performance?
- Is it worth further investment to scale-up or replicate?
- Is doing/funding this better than doing/funding that?
- What can be communicated about it to others?



## **How to build M&E into your work**

- Budget
  - how much?
- How will stakeholders make use of the information?
- Plan to monitor & evaluate from the beginning
  - retrospective M&E is difficult
- It is not rocket science
  - you do M&E all the time, without thinking
- Working with multiple funders / stakeholders
  - involve them in discussions/planning
  - agree on one M&E and reporting plan
