Objective of the working group	Notion of combination prevention is fully understood and adopted by all member states and includes a minimum package of biomedical, behavioural , structural evidence based prevention package
Sub-objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To ensure that the implementation of combination prevention is included in the joint action for MSM</li> <li>- To ensure appropriate actions to scale up combination prevention, taking the gaps and barriers identified by the INTEGRATE joint action into account</li> <li>- acknowledge TasP/U=U as a powerful tool in combination prevention for HIV</li> </ul>
Outputs, deliverables, products	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To release a policy statement on the necessity to implement at scale combination prevention including treatment as prevention and following action deriving from the identified gaps and barriers from the INTEGRATE project</li> <li>- Letter to Head of Commission and the SG in relation to the promotion on the planned JA on MSM. This will include evidence based guidance on combination prevention under sufficient involvement of civil society organisations</li> </ul>
