Core thematic areas 2015 - 2017

- a) Improved access to HIV services and treatment for **migrants with irregular status**
- b) **Affordability** of medicines, specifically regarding HIV and hepatitis C treatment
- c) Community based voluntary counselling and testing (**CBVCT**) outside medical settings
- d) Upscaling access to **prevention for gay men and other MSM** (PrEP, gay apps)
- e) Advocacy for a **new policy framework** at EU-level
- f) Advocacy at international level (**UNAIDS PCB**)
- g) Reducing **stigma and discrimination** in order to ensure access to prevention, treatment and care for key populations as cross-sectional theme

Strategic Directions for AAE 2018 - 2021
