

IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

PRELIMINARY RESULTS OF THE AAE MEMBER ORGANISATIONS SURVEY

First results of the survey show that AAE member organisations are struggling heavily with the impact of COVID-19 induced measures. The survey was live from 4 June to 24 June 2020.

43 Organizations from

29 Countries* filled in the survey
28 in English and 15 in Russian.

A longer report will be published after a more thorough analysis of the quantitative and qualitative data.

These are the preliminary data of the first part of a two-phase survey.

The same questions will be addressed in December 2020 to the same organisations who responded the first part in order to monitor developments and changes of the COVID-19 situation.

Of the organizations provided face-to-face services before the COVID-19 outbreak.



Provided online services to their clients before the outbreak of COVID-19.

58% Stopped or reduced face-to-face services due to COVID-19 policies and measures.

92.5% Already moved some of their face-to-face services to an online format.

71.8% Are planning to move further services online.

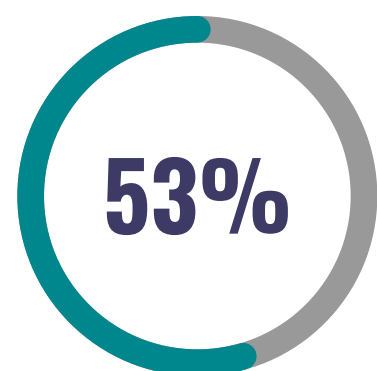

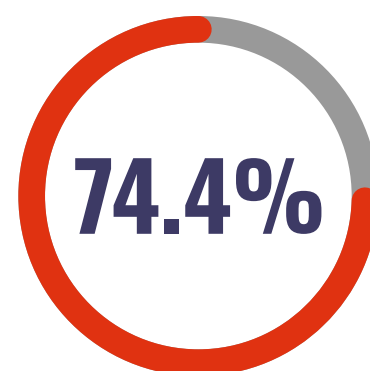
Of the organisations had to invest funds into the application of new hygiene measures.
