- You have a relevant university degree preferably in the field of social and communications sciences or similar educational degree and at least two years of relevant professional experience;

- You have experience in international cooperation and intercultural communication;
- You have a very good knowledge of and experience in working with content management systems (ideally Drupal);

- You have excellent Russian and English writing and speaking skills (and you are willing to learn German on the job);
- You have a solid knowledge about HIV/AIDS as well as high communicative competence and intercultural sensitivity;
- You identify with the goals and the mission of AIDS Action Europe and Deutsche Aidshilfe, and you are sensitive towards the diversity of people and communities living with and affected by HIV;
